Wesley: What do you mean?

Tecumseh-Williams: I understand you work at (redacted). Is that correct?

Wesley: What do you mean this is not the correct person?

Tecumseh-Williams: It's something wrong. This is not the person. Did you check all the records?

Wesley: I'm not...

Tecumseh-Williams: *unintelligible*

Wesley: That is the person who assaulted me in 2019. Yes, ma'am.

Tecumseh-Williams: We don't, we don't have that. There are no records to show that. Can you, can you possibly send something to me that says that there's, that there's a conviction in here for that.

Wesley: There's no conviction that I'm aware of.

Tecumseh-Williams: Oh, we don't, we don't have that information anywhere.

Wesley: My assault was not reported, nor were (redacted) that I am aware of.

Tecumseh-Williams: Okay. So I'm just, I'm just trying to figure out because we are going to have to have, we're going to have to have that conversation with our Chief because it's coming out on social media. Um, and I'm just going to let you know that our Attorney General's office may be in contact with you. I just needed, because we, I mean, we take this very seriously. So we do want to make sure that we are covering all our bases and making sure that we have all the information that we need. Um, you know, I...I'm sorry that this is happening, we just don't have any of that information.

Wesley: Right. Um, I'm not surprised you don't have that information. And that's why I posted privately and not publicly. Because I know that at least the incidents that I'm aware of were not, um, reported to police including (redacted).

Tecumseh-Williams: *unintelligible* Go ahead...

Wesley: But that's why it was not posted publicly because I was simply offering a safe place of support for anyone else that needed, that had also that, you know, that may have also been, um, had similar experiences with him to talk if they needed to.

Tecumseh-Williams: Okay, well, unfortunately, it has come out of private and it's being circulated at our tribe and so, at this point, everything is going to have to be turned into our Attorney General's office. And that's one thing is that you possibly may get contacted.

Wesley: I will certainly speak with them if they would like to speak with me.

Tecumseh-Williams: Okay. And just, I mean, I just wanted to give you a heads up but we don't have any of that information. We looked through all of that and we looked up records and like you said it wasn't reported and, and unfortunately *unintelligible* the social media post has been shared publicly. Well, I, I just, I was shocked to hear any of that. And I'm not, you know, by no means, you know, doubting your words by at all I just wanted to just, I'm just trying to follow up on what I've been asked to follow up on and so I thought I would give you a call, um, you know, and at this point just to let you know, we're you know, kind of where we're at also okay?

Wesley: Sure, yes, I appreciate that.

Tecumseh-Williams: All right, thank you. I appreciate you calling me right back.
